Beach Mile participants will pick up their race bibs on race morning (Saturday) at no extra charge.

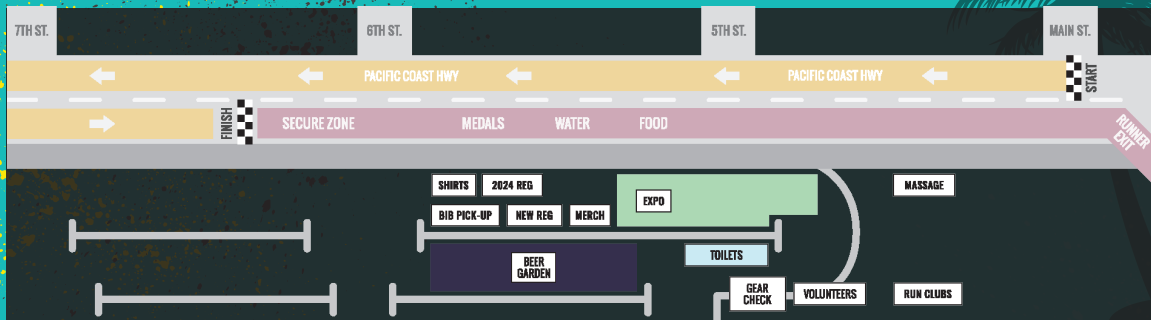

## SATURDAY MICHELOB ULTRA BEER GARDEN

All Sunday participants, 21 years of age and older, are eligible to receive (1) complimentary beverage on Saturday and (1) complimentary beverage on Sunday in the Michelob ULTRA Beer Garden. Each participant bib will have a box designating a Saturday Beer and a Sunday Beer that will be checked off when collecting your beverage. Choose between Michelob ULTRA, Nutri Vodka Seltzer, or Kona Big Wave at the beer garden.

Additional beverages can be purchased in the Beer Garden for \$5 with proceeds going to Ainsley's Angels to support their quest to build awareness about the importance of inclusion, through action, while transforming populations into all-inclusive communities.

To continue our support of [Ainsley's Angels](#), participants will only be able to collect one complimentary beer on Saturday and/or Sunday and will not be able to combine beers to collect more than (1) complimentary beer on either day. Per the rules of our event permit, patrons in the Beer Garden will be limited to a maximum of 3 beverages per day. Last call will be at 4:00pm.

# BEACH MILE

## PARKING

There are multiple parking lots within easy walking distance of the start/finish line of Surf City 10 Miler. The suggested parking lots are listed below. Parking rates are subject to change at any time and are set by individual lot operators, not the race organizers.

Main Promenade Parking Structure (200 Main Street, Huntington Beach) first 90 minutes free, after 90 minutes, \$1 each 20 minutes, \$15 max daily

Pacific City Parking (access via Pacific View Ave between 1st Street & Huntington Ave) \$2 per 15 minutes, \$40 max daily

Plaza Almeria Parking Structure (301 Main Street, Huntington Beach) \$1 per 20 minutes, \$15 max daily

5th & PCH Parking (146 Sixth Street, Huntington Beach) first 2 hours, \$2, after 2 hours, \$2 per 20 minutes, \$18 max daily

Beach Parking Lot (off Pacific Coast Highway, enter at Beach Blvd ONLY (access will be prohibited by law enforcement at Huntington Street and 1st Street across PCH), \$15 daily

# RACE DAY

## GEAR CHECK- ALL DISTANCES

Opens at 5:30am, closes at 10:30am

Gear Check will be available for all participants. Gear Check will be located in the parking lots adjacent to Huntington Beach Pier Plaza, just below the Race Expo. Gear Check will remain in the same location throughout the duration of the race.

Clear gear check bags will be provided at bib pick-up. All items must be placed in this clear bag.

Luggage or large bags will not be accepted.

Please attach the gear check tag on your bib to your clear plastic bag using the provided cable ties.

Gear check will be sorted by alphabetically by last name. Please pay attention to the posted signs and drop your gear off in the section corresponding with the first letter(s) of your last name. You will be able to pick-up your gear check bag from the same location after the race.

**HOT TIP:** Pay attention to which lane number your last name is associated with. You will need to return to the same lane to retrieve your items.

# PARKING

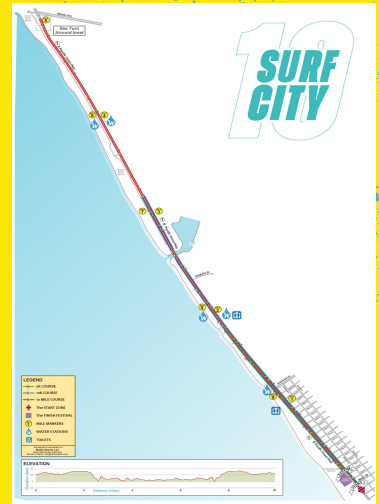
Plaza Almeria Parking Structure (301 Main Street, Huntington Beach) \$1 per 20 minutes, \$15 max daily

5th & PCH Parking (146 Sixth Street, Huntington Beach) first 2 hours, \$2, after 2 hours, \$2 per 20 minutes, \$18 max daily

Beach Parking Lot (off Pacific Coast Highway, enter at Beach Blvd ONLY (access will be prohibited by law enforcement at Huntington Street and 1st Street across PCH), \$15 daily

Bike Valet will not be provided on race day at Huntington Beach Pier Plaza however, participants planning on riding their bicycles are welcome to use bike racks found along the beach path or in Downtown Huntington Beach. Please do not lock your bike on the bike rack that forms the start and finish chutes on Pacific Coast Highway.

Please find the locations of the aid stations along each of the three courses listed below. Water and Ghost Hydration Kiwi Strawberry and Lemon Crush Electrolytes will be provided at the stations listed below.

10 Miler Stations: Miles 2.2, 4, 6.1, 7.8, 9

10K Stations: Miles 2.2, 4, 5.1

5K Stations: Mile 2

Charge! athletic gel (Flavors: Grape, Strawberry & Green Applewill) also be provided on the 10 Miler course at the aid station at Mile 6.1.

## WRISTBANDS

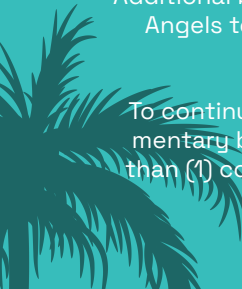
Those that are 21 years of age and older and plan on visiting the Beer Garden must present their ID at the ID check tent to obtain a wristband prior to entering the beer garden. Per the rules of our event permit, you must pick up your wristband on the day you plan to enter the beer garden – you cannot pick up a wristband on Saturday to be used on Sunday.

## AWARDS

The top 3 male and female finishers overall in the 10 Miler, 10K, and 5K will receive an award. The top (1st) male and female finishers in each age group (listed below) will also receive an award. To allow for winner verification, age awards will not be available on site and will be mailed to age group winners within a couple of weeks of the event.

14 & Under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80+

## GOLDEN STATE CHALLENGE MEDALS

Participants that are completing their fourth Golden State Challenge race are eligible to pick-up their challenge medal at Surf City 10. Participants that are eligible will receive an email with further instructions and can pick-up their medal at the Golden State Challenge tent in Race Expo. To be eligible for the Golden State Challenge medal pick up at Surf City 10, participants must have completed a 5K or longer distance at (4) of the following events:

- Surf City Marathon & Half Marathon (February)
- Santa Barbara Wine Country Half Marathon (May)
- Bay to Breakers (May)
- Napa to Sonoma Wine Country Half Marathon (July)
- Surf City 10 (September)
